All clubs are seeking candidates to run for the office of:

- **President:** leads the monthly club meetings, ensures that the officers provide reports on club business, and strives to engage all members in club activities.
- **Vice President:** works with the president to provide leadership and direction for the club's educational programs.
- **Secretary:** maintain accurate minutes of each meeting and keep accurate attendance of each meeting.

Volunteer Adults/Leaders "Working With Minors" Training MUST Be completed each year

As we begin the new year, it is time for our adult Volunteers to take the "Working with Minors" module for the 2021-2022 year. To make this process easier, a reset button has been added.

Once you are in his/her/family Zsuite account and have selected his/her profile, follow the steps below:

- 1. Click on Clover Academy on left menu bar
- 2. Launch Clover Academy
- 3. Open NM Working with Minors (even though it says completed)
- 4. Under 'You have earned a certificate' is a button that says "Reset All Course Progress for the New Year (Cannot be undone)'
- 5. Click on the blue 'Reset All Course Progress for the New Year (Cannot be undone)'
- 6. Start Course

Complete course and a certificate will be available online for you to view with the completion date. If you have completed the training online, the Extension office will be notified of completion date. State 4-H mandates that your enrollment will not be approved without the Working with Minor's Training completed.

- ► All Family's have to register as a <u>New</u> Household (Parent/Guardian)
- Link for Enrollments: 4h.zsuite.org
- ► Open Enrollment for Sandoval County: <u>October 15, 2021</u>

Online Video Tutorial will be available soon

- ► Every household is under <u>ONE</u> account
- **•** Only one email and password (PIN) is used by everyone in family.

Zsuites works on a Live Chat format!

- ► Live Chat will pop up automatically on the bottom right hand of your screen
- ► You can use Live Chat from 6:00am until 3:00pm MT for questions & help.
- ► If you are filling out information, the help link has an online manual.

Since we have transferred to 4hZsuites, no 4-H enrollment information will roll over. Every enrollment now has to be entered brand new.

YOU must enroll yourselves

Mandatory Requirements that have not changed

- ► Members MUST submit a current signed medical release/liability form.
- Adults/Volunteers Must be screened within 5 years and participate in the Working with Minors workshop. Adults, if you have already used zSuite to complete the annual working with Minors training, you do not need to create a new account. You can work off your existing account.
- ► zSuite is very mobile friendly, and you can do all of this on your phone.
- ► The zSuite system has a lot of great features. It is home for all things 4-H.

Scholarship Information

A Scholarship fund has been established by the 4-H County Council to provide financial assistance to 4-H members that wish to attend State, District, or County 4-H events. Scholarship will cover 50% of the registration expenses for Senior Leadership Retreat, Youth-Get-Away, Livestock School, Horse School, Home Ec School, 4-H Dog School, or \$250 of the team fees for serving as a State 4-H Officer, Ambassador, or a Diplomat. The scholarship will cover 100% of the registration expenses for 4-H County Camp. **The funding may not be used to attend State 4-H Conference, State 4-H Shooting Sports Contest, nor District Contest. Scholarship Criteria**—Available to any Novice, Junior or Senior 4-H Member.
