Ways to Contribute

As a Buyer: You as an individual have the pleasure of bidding up the sale, making it fast and exciting.

Group Bidding: Two or more individuals, families or businesses may wish to split the cost of an animal.

By Donation to Sandoval County

4-H Amigos: Individuals or businesses commit a dollar amount to the Amigos buyers pool. The Amigos will then bid on and purchase animals, leveraging the available money to maximize the benefit to participating youth.

Add-Ons: You as an individual or business can designate a certain amount to be added-on to any person or group you choose.

Buyers have four options following the sale:

1. Have animal processed for your own personal consumption.
2. Re-sell the animal back to the packer at market value (Buyers would pay the purchase price minus the market value).
3. Donate re-sell money or meat to charity of their choice.
4. Take possession of the live animal.
