4-H Programming

4-H is available for children ages 9-19. Cloverbud programs are available for children ages 5-8. Based on their interests, vouth select from over 200 4-H projects in areas like health, science, agriculture and citizenship. There are hands-on, learn-bydoing opportunities for everyone.

4-H is a Community

Our network of 80 volunteers and two 4-H professionals provides caring and supportive mentoring to all 300 4-H'ers, helping them grow into true leaders today and in life.

Sandoval County 4-H Delivery Modes

Club Programs

Youth, ages 5-18, can join a club, which meets on a regular scheduled basis over an extended period of time during the 4-H Youth Development Program year. The 4-H year is October through September.

School Enrichment Programs

Youth, ages 5-18, can belong to a 4-H school enrichment group which occurs during school hours. Group topics include: Ag in the Classroom, Embryology, Gardening, Animal Science, Health & Safety, Environmental Education, Nutrition and Fitness and Exploring 4-H.

Special Interest Programs

Youth, ages 5-18, can belong to a 4-H special interest group, focusing on subject matter topics for a minimum of six hours outside of school hours. Programs include: Water Conservation, Communications, Ecology, Child Development, Gardening, Nutrition and Fitness, Bee Keeping, Rocketry, Service Learning, Robotics, Aerospace, Character Education and Food Safety.
