4. Dogs must be at least six months old.
5. Walkers may walk up to 2 dogs.
6. No dogs in heat—please!
7. You must clean up after your dog.
8. Please be careful: even the best dog can bite!

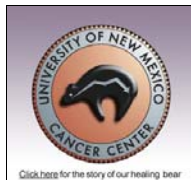
