



#### **Scholarship Information**

A Scholarship fund has been established by the 4-H County Council to provide financial assistance to 4-H members that wish to attend State, District, or County 4-H events. Scholarship will cover 50% of the registration expenses for Senior Leadership Retreat, Youth-Get-Away, Livestock School, Horse School, Home Ec School, 4-H Dog School, or \$250 of the team fees for serving as a State 4-H Officer, Ambassador, or a Diplomat. The scholarship will cover 100% of the registration expenses for 4-H County Camp.

The funding may not be used to attend State 4-H Conference, State 4-H Shooting Sports Contest, nor District Contest. **Scholarship Criteria—**Available to any Novice, Junior or Senior 4-H Member.

Thank you to all who took the time and completed Portfolios! Other County Agents judged them and were quite impressed! We had several Cloverbuds who turned in their portfolios too!

Why Record Books? It starts with a project and ends with records in a Portfolio!

- To have a life time memory and record of what you have done in 4-H.
- To establish good habits of organizing, planning, evaluating, and setting goals
- Each year your portfolio builds on the last
- Universities across the nation look at participation in 4-H and these can serve as a scholarship tool! We are after all, New Mexico State University!
- Other businesses tend to hire someone if their resume notes 4-H
- And, we can give you a letter of reference, if you have attended all club meetings, have been an active participant in 4-H and completed a portfolio each year.

Avoid the Rush—Get started early! When you enroll, think about your projects and make a folder and start organizing your portfolio. In January, begin recording items in a record book. Include photos too! Project photos should show you working with your project. Example: A picture of a target is not good, but a picture of you in a position, ready to shoot a target is much better! We had some very creative 4-Hers this year!

Take a little time each month and bring your book up to date

### What Makes a Good Portfolio?

- Should be neat and clean
- You may ask your parents to help you, but the work must be your own
- Take your portfolio to club and project meetings
- Underline your own name in clippings or go over them with a highlighter marker. The judges see everything! Judges are other county agents trained to judge portfolio's on a point system.
- Items NOT to include in your record book are:
- Fair ribbons
- Any material not related to your project
- Programs for events
- Last year's records unless requested
- Project literature
- ... Signature and comments—make sure your record book is signed by you, your parent/guardian, Club Leader and the 4-H Agent.
- ... All portfolios must be submitted to Extension office in a timely manner.

One year we had over 80 Portfolios turned in! Let's break that record in 2024!







## 4-H Member Ages For 2023-2024 4-H Year Before January 1, 2024

CLOVERBUD: 5 to 8, years old AND in Kindergarten, 1st or 2nd grade

**NOVICE:** 9 to 11 years old or 8 years old AND in the 3rd grade. **JUNIOR:** 12 and 13 years old or 11 years old AND in 6th grade. **SENIOR:** 14 to 18 years old or 13 years old AND in 8th grade

Youth who are 19 on or by December 31 of the current 4-H year (2023) are NOT eligible to en-

roll as a 4-H member.
